*Admission Brochure for the Session 2019-2020*

The College offers semester pattern (CBCS) Honours and General Under Graduate (Bachelor) courses in Humanities (Arts) & Science under the affiliation of the Vidyasagar University.

1. Application for admission in B.A. and B. Sc. (Hon's & Gen) courses in the session 2019-2020 **shall be online only**. Online Application Forms for admission will be available from Narajole Raj College Website: <http://www.narajolerajcollege.ac.in> on and from 28-05-2019. The direct link to the Admission Portal is <http://ugadmission.narajolerajcollege.ac.in/>. The admission will be strictly on **Merit Basis**. The admission schedule is appended herewith.

**Note: No printed Application Form** will be issued from the College. Application will be considered only upon payment of the requisite **Application Fees (Rs.100/-) per application**. Payments will be made by online mode only. **No request for deposit of admission fees in the College Cash Counter will be entertained. There will be no need to come to the College Office for any matter relating to filling up of admission forms.** Applicants are requested to visit the College Web-site on a regular basis for relevant information and updates.

**Eligibility:**

Students must have passed HS examination with minimum 45% marks in the aggregate or 50% marks in the Subject or Related Subject to apply for admission in Honours Course.

2. During the period of admission procedure the college shall maintain a helpline for the students on 24 hours and 7 days basis only for sorting out technical issues or for clearing any doubt regarding procedural aspects of such admission. 3. A candidate may apply for one or more than one subject that she/he is eligible for and the application fees shall be paid for each application. Actual application fees on the basis of the number of subjects applied for must be submitted, otherwise, the form(s) will be cancelled and no refund will be made.
4. An SMS will be sent to each applicant after the successful submission of the application form with requisite fee (s).
5. Any wrong data given may lead to cancellation of the candidature summarily. It is within the sole discretion of the college authority to reject any application or admission.
6. Candidates have to download Transaction Acknowledgement Slip and the finally submitted Application Form. The printed copy of downloaded Application Form and Transaction Acknowledge Slip alongwith the following documents are to be kept by the candidates for future use.
  - i) **Mark Sheet** of the last qualifying examination (e.g. Higher Secondary Examination);
  - ii) **Caste Certificate**, if applicable (from the competent authority only);
  - iii) **Admit Card** of the Madhyamik or equivalent Board evidencing the age of the candidate or **Birth Certificate**;

- iv) *Registration Certificate* of the Higher Secondary (WBCHSE) or Equivalent Board;
  - v) *PH/VH Certificate*, if applicable (from the competent authority only).
  - vi) Candidates have to upload above mentioned testimonials and his/her *scanned signature* and *photograph* at the time of filling up their forms.
7. All the information relating to the admission will be given to the applicant in the form of SMS in the mobile number furnished/registered by the applicant in the Online Application Form. The college will not be liable for non-receipt of relevant information because of wrong mobile number or furnishing of mobile number other than that of his/her own. Students are also requested to furnish their own e-mail ID so that it can be used effectively for the purpose of circulation of important and necessary information to the intended recipient.
  8. All the above mentioned documents and testimonials shall be produced by the admitted candidate, for verification, in original when he/she comes to the college on commencement of his/her 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Classes. The date of commencement of classes is 02-07-2019. The admission of any candidate shall stand cancelled summarily if, on verification, any of the documents, testimonials or information furnished or given by candidate is found to be false, wrong, incorrect or insufficient.
  9. As this college is affiliated to Vidyasagar University, the college is liable to follow its guideline on admission, registration, examinations and so on and the students have to follow the guidelines strictly.
  10. College shall not be liable for admission/ranking in the Merit List in case candidate's previous 10+2 board is not approved by the Vidyasagar University.
  11. In case of Board/ Council other than W.B.C.H.S.E, A candidate shall have to pass in five [four, where applicable] recognized subjects of full marks not being less than 100 each of which one shall be English. For them the merit point will be calculated converting their % of marks into 500.
  12. Marks obtained in top five subjects (including at least one language) shall be considered to ascertain the aggregate marks of a candidate passing the examination under grades system. The merit point of an applicant will be judged by taking into account 10% of the marks obtained in best five subjects (including one language) and the marks obtained in the subject applied for.
  13. Marks obtained in Environmental Education as compulsory subject at the H.S. (10 +2) Examination conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary education or equivalents shall not be taken into account for calculation of the aggregate marks in top five subjects for the purpose of admission
  14. Without prior and written permission from Vidyasagar University, no candidate shall be considered for admission after lapse of more than 3 (three) years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination or discontinuation of recognized regular courses of study after passing the previous qualifying examination. Also, candidate of 2017 and 2018 who have registered their name in Vidyasagar University are not eligible to apply until s (he) declared failed. Here, also proper permission of Vidyasagar University is required.  
*Explanation:* An applicant passed HS (10+2) level in the year 2019 is eligible to apply for BA/B Sc Courses in this college. Candidates who passed 10+2 level in the year 2017 or 2018 and who did not register themselves as student in Vidyasagar University are also eligible to apply.
  15. The candidates qualifying the vocational courses can apply for general degree courses only.

### Selection Procedure

1. Selection will be made strictly on merit basis.
2. Merit point will be calculated by adding 10% of total marks obtained in the 'best five' subjects at Higher Secondary / equivalent examination and the marks obtained in the subject in which the admission in Core Course (Honours) is sought. The first language will be treated as

For example:

- Total marks obtained in the 'Best Five' subjects:350
- 10% of total marks in the 'Best Five' subjects:35
- Marks obtained in the subject in which the Admission in Core Course (Honours) is sought:70
- Credit points: 35+70 =105

**N.B.:** All the above mentioned rules may be changed as per decision of the college authority
