About the Seminar

Four decades ago, a unique approach namely Subaltern Studies emerged in the field of Social Sciences. Rejecting the existing approaches that throw light only on the upper and elite sections of the society and ignore the marginalities, the approach attempts to listen to the unheard voices and rewrite history for the Other - the subaltern - in terms of class, caste, gender, race, language and culture. The Subaltern Studies Group aims to focus on the working class and particularly on "peasant" historical accounts in post-colonial and post-imperial South Asia and India. Reflections on subaltern studies in the society, specially in India, has also become visible and functioning and has generated considerable critical enquiry.

After four decades, Subaltern Studies has gained both acceptability and criticism. Criticisms against subaltern studies from inside and outside create more curiosity about it. This seminar aims to explore the complex debates around the subaltern thought through academic deliberation.
